### Description

Valle Giulia is the seat of the Modern Art Gallery and of the faculty of architecture of the La Sapienza Rome's University. The Battle of Valle Giulia is the conventional name for a clash between Italian left-wing militants and the Italian police at Valle Giulia, Rome, on 1 March 1968. It is still frequently remembered as one of the first violent clashes in Italy's student unrest during the protests of 1968. The image shows Policemen and a civilian in an urban building, it is unclear from the two different inscriptions on the back of the photograph whether this is a picture of the Valle Giulia event or of another event that took place in Bologna in 1972.
