**Description**

Giulio Andreotti was the 41st Prime Minister of Italy and leader of the Christian Democracy party. Aldo Bozzi was an Italian politician. He was an exponent of the Italian Liberal Party and MP since 1953, was undersecretary of Finance during the first Segni cabinet and Minister of Transport and Civil Aviation during the second Andreotti government. Benedetto "Bettino" Craxi was an Italian politician, head of the Italian Socialist Party from 1976 to 1993 and Prime Minister of Italy from 1983 to 1987. He was the first member of the PSI to hold the office, as well as the third Prime Minister from a socialist party. Vincenzo Balzamo was an Italian politician, Minister for the coordination of initiatives for the scientific and technological research in 1979 and the Minister for Transport in 1982. Renato Altissimo was an Italian politician and minister. Altissimo was a member of the Italian Liberal Party (Partito Liberale Italiano, PLI), a small party which served as a junior partner in several governing coalitions. Valerio Zanone is an Italian politician, who was secretary and president of the Italian Liberal Party. He was also a senator of the Democratic Party. The main dynamic of Italian post-war politics was to find a way to keep the Italian Communist Party out of power. This led to the constant formation of political alliances between parties keen on keeping the Communists at bay.
