Description

Giulio Andreotti was the 41st Prime Minister of Italy and leader of the Christian Democracy party. Giuseppe Zamberletti is an Italian politician, one of the founders of Italy's Protezione Civile (Civil Protection), of which he was the first minister in Italy from 1981. A member of Christian Democracy, he was elected for the first time to the Italian Chamber of Deputies in 1968. After his re-election in 1972, he became undersecretary for Interior Affairs in the Moro IV, Moro V and Andreotti III governments, with responsibility for public security, the Vigili del Fuoco (Firemen Corps) and Civil Protection. Tina Anselmi, Cavaliere di Gran Croce OMRI is an Italian politician, and a notable member of the Italian resistance movement during the World War II. Francesco Cossiga, OMRI was an Italian politician of the Christian Democracy party. He was the 42nd Prime Minister of Italy from 1979 to 1980 and the eighth President of Italy from 1985 to 1992. Franco Evangelisti was an Italian politician, a member of Democrazia Cristiana and a long-standing follower of Giulio Andreotti. Thomas Morlino was an Italian politician, and he was one of the creators of the

Italian regional system. He served in the Italian Senate from 1968 , he was the Undersecretary of the Budget from 1973 to 1974 , Minister for the Regions from 1974 to 1976 , Minister for the Budget and Economic Planning and the Regions from 1976 to 1979 , Minister of Justice from 1979 to 1980 , President of the Senate from 9 December 1982.
