Christian Democracy party members Emilio Colombo, Bruno Visentini, Antonio Bisaglia and Giulio Andreotti after a political assembly. Giulio Andreotti was the 41st Prime Minister of Italy and leader of the Christian Democracy party. Antonio Bisaglia (1929 – 1984) was an Italian politician, a member of Christian Democracy (Democrazia Cristiana, or DC). Bruno Visentini (1914 - 1995) was an Italian politician, senator, minister, lecturer and industrialist. In the 1976 election he was elected Senator and in 1979 he became vice-premier and Minister for budget in Giulio Andreotti's fifth government after Ugo La Malfa's death until he resigned the following July. Emilio Colombo (1920 – 2013) was an Italian politician and the Prime Minister of Italy from 1970 to 1972. In addition to having held top positions in Italian governments, he was also active in European politics. In 2003 he was appointed to be an Italian senator for life, a seat which he held until his death.
