Oronzo Reale (1902 – 1988) was an Italian politician, who served as justice minister in the 1960s and 1970s. Giulio Andreotti was the 41st Prime Minister of Italy and leader of the Christian Democracy party. Bruno Visentini (1914 - 1995) was an Italian politician, senator, minister, lecturer and industrialist. In the 1976 election he was elected Senator and in 1979 he became vice-premer and Minister for budget in Giulio Andreotti's fifth government after Ugo La Malfa's death until he resigned the following July. Emilio Colombo (1920 – 2013) was an Italian politician and the Prime Minister of Italy from 1970 to 1972. In addition to having held top positions in Italian governments, he was also active in European politics. In 2003 he was appointed to be an Italian senator for life, a seat which he held until

his death. Arnaldo Forlani (b.1925) is an Italian politician who served as the 43rd Prime Minister of Italy from 18 October 1980 to 28 June 1981. He was previously a member of the right-wing of the Italian Christian Democratic Party.
