The Radical Party (Italian: Partito Radicale, PR) was a political party in Italy. For decades it was a bastion of liberalism and radicalism in Italy and proposed itself as the strongest opposition to the Italian political establishment, seen as corrupt and conservative. Fuori! the acronym Italian Revolutionary Homosexual United Front ) was an association active in the seventies and dedicated to the fight for gay rights.
