**Description**

The Marzabotto massacre occurred during World War II. At least 770 civilians were murdered by Nazis near the small village of Marzabotto, in the mountainous area south of Bologna. It was the worst massacre of civilians committed by the Waffen SS in Western Europe during the war.
