Description

Nicola Signorello is a politician. He was mayor of Rome and Minister of the Republic. He joined the Christian Democrats and was initially close to Mario Scelba , but later he joined forces with Giulio Andreotti , becoming one of the more prominent members in Rome along with Amerigo Petrucci and Franco Evangelisti . Mariano Rumor was an Italian politician. A member of the Christian Democracy Party, he served as Prime Minister of Italy from 1968 to 1970 and again from 1973 to 1974. During his periods as prime minister, a number of progressive reforms were carried out. A law of 11 December 1969 extended access to higher education to all students holding a higher secondary school diploma (formerly limited to students who came from classical (and in some cases, scientific) curricula. A law of 30 April 1969 introduced broad provisions covering pensions under the general scheme. Alitalia – Linee Aeree Italiane S.p.A. was established on 16 September 1946 as Aerolinee Italiane Internazionali. It was formed as a result of an Anglo-Italian agreement and was funded by the Italian Government and British European Airways (BEA) in a 60 /40 share arrangement with a capital of 900 million lire (£1,000,000). Its popular name, Alitalia, was an Italian portmanteau of the words ali (wings) and Italia (Italy). It started operations on 5 May 1947, in which year it carried over 10,000 passengers.
