Pietro Ingrao was an Italian politician and journalist. For many years he was a senior figure in the Italian Communist Party (PCI). He was the first Communist to become President of the Italian Chamber of Deputies, a position he held from 1976 to 1979. Marco Pannella is an Italian politician. He is the historic leader of the Radical Party (the first expression of the Radicals in post-World War II Italy was the Italian Radical Party, founded in 1955). Antonio Maccanico was an Italian constitutional specialist and social liberal politician, who served in various capacities in the parliament and federal administrations of Italy.
