He was also a member of the masonic lodge P2, a right-wing secret society of politicians, judges, policemen, judges and dodgy businessmen. Giovanni Mosca was a journalist, cartoonist and author, also vice secretary of the PSI at one point. Claudio Signorile is an Italian academic, and politician with the Italian Socialist Party (PSI).
