Description

Emilio Colombo was an Italian politician and the Prime Minister of Italy from 1970 to 1972. He was a member of the Christian Democrats Anthony Barber was a British politician of the 1960s and 70s. He worked closely with Edward Heath, first as Tory party chairman and then as chancellor of the exchequer. The sudden death of Iain Macleod shortly after Heath's election victory in 1970 provided Barber's opportunity at No 11 Downing Street. Heath's overriding ambition was to secure British membership of Europe. Barber was to be lead minister in the negotiations.
