Description

Emilio Colombo was an Italian politician and the Prime Minister of Italy from 1970 to 1972. He was a member of the Christian Democrats. Aldo Romeo Luigi Moro was a Christian Democrat politician and the 38th Prime Minister of Italy, from 1963 to 1968, and then from 1974 to 1976. He was one of Italy's longest-serving post-war Prime Ministers, holding power for a combined total of more than six years. Moro was considered an intellectual and a patient mediator, especially in the internal life of his party. He was kidnapped on March 16, 1978, by the Red Brigades, a Marxist–Leninist urban guerilla organisation, and killed after 55 days of captivity.
