Description

Benedetto "Bettino" Craxi was an Italian politician, head of the Italian Socialist Party from 1976 to 1993 and Prime Minister of Italy from 1983 to 1987. He was the first member of the PSI to hold the office, as well as the third Prime Minister from a socialist party. Giacomo Mancini was a politician, leading member of the Italian Socialist Party and Minister of the Republic. Giovanni Mosca became deputy secretary of the National PSI in 1972: he resigned at the end of the elections of 1976, which marked a major setback for the Socialists. With the advent of Bettino Craxi, he withdrew from active politics. Enrico Manca was a journalist and politician. In 1959 he entered the RAI and from 1961 to 1972 he was editor of the Giornale Radio Rai, managing editor of TV News and director of cultural services of television. He was a member of the Italian Socialist Party, and was deputy from 1972 to 1994 and Minister of Foreign Trade in the government Cossiga II and in the Forlani government. His name was found in the entry lists the lodge Masonic P2.
