Description

Vittorio Sereni was an Italian poet, author, editor and translator of Jewish heritage. His poetry frequently addressed the themes of 20th-century Italian history, such as Fascism, Italy's military defeat in World War II, and its postwar resurgence. Camilla Ravera was an Italian politician and the first female lifetime senator. Ravera participated in the founding of the Italian Communist Party in 1921, and throughout her life was involved with its politics, representing them in the House for two terms between 1948 and 1958, then in 1982 she retired from public life.
