Description

Giancarlo Pajetta was an Italian communist politician. Pajetta was born in Turin and become a member of the Italian Communist Party during his youth. In 1927, this earned him a two-year prison sentence. In 1948 Pajetta became a member of the National Secretariat of the PCI, with responsibility for its international relationships. He remained in the national secretariat until 1985. He was also elected in the Italian Parliament from 1946 until his death, and in the European Parliament in 1984. He was also repeatedly director of L'Unità (PCI's newspaper) and of the Marxist periodical Rinascita.
