Description

Anita Pasquali, was a leading figure of the UDI in Rome and who supported the organisation's feminist turn, remembering this period as a heyday of feminist action and influence, Pasqualit Maud Bracke in a telephone interview in 2012: "I speak now from the perspective of the UDI, but also more generally I think. The mobilisation on sexual violence around 1980 heralded a new phase in feminist campaigning, when we really were able to impact on wider debate and political decision making. For me, it was in the following years that feminism reached its highest point of visibility."
