Description

Francesco "Ciccio" Graziani (born 1952) is an Italian football manager and former football player who played as a forward. With 122 total goals scored for Torino, he is the seventh highest scorer in the history of the Torinese club behind Valentino Mazzola (123) and with 23 official goals, the ninth highest all-time scorer for the Italian national team (tied with Christian Vieri), with whom he won the 1982 FIFA World Cup. Graziani was also an important international player for Italy, representing the Azzurri at the 1978 FIFA World Cup (where they finished in fourth place after reaching the semi-final), their victorious 1982 FIFA World Cup campaign, and the 1980 European Championship (where they finished in fourth place after reaching the semi-final, once again). He debuted 19 April 1975 against Poland and scored his first goal on 7 April 1976 against Portugal.
