Description

Flilippo Micheli, a deputy for 46 years (1948-1994), Minister of State for Finance, Industry and Commerce, a member of the Christian Democrats in 1969 appointed him as national secretary Administrative Party. Carlo Donat-Cattin (26 June 1919 – 17 March 1991) was an Italian politician and trade unionist. A member of Christian Democracts, he was several times minister of the Italian Republic. Belonging to the left wing of the party, in 1978 he became vice-secretary of DC. Donat-Cattin was initially in favour of dialogue towards DC's historical rival, the Italian Communist Party (PCI), but after 1979 he became a supporter of the Preambolo theory, which aimed to exclude PCI from any state charge. In 1980, however, after his son Marco was discovered to be a member of the far-left terrorist formation Prima Linea, he abandoned any public position and left politics for a while.
