Description

Lotta Continua, shortened to LC, was one of the major extra-parliamentary parties of the Italian Left, and was active between the end of the sixties and the first half of the seventies. Mariano "Mario" Lupo was a Communist militant who trained with Lotta Continua. He died from being stabbed in the heart after being attacked by neo-fascists on 25 August 1972.
