Description

Politicians in the photo include: Giovanni Leone was an Italian politician. He was the 37th Prime Minister of Italy from 21 June 1963 to 4 December 1963 and again from 24 June 1968 to 12 December 1968. He also served as the sixth President of the Republic from 1971 to 1978. Adone Zoli (16 December 1887 – 20 February 1960) was an Italian politician and member of the Christian Democracy. He served as the 35th Prime Minister of Italy from 1957-1958. Amintore Fanfani was an Italian politician and Prime Minister of Italy. He was one of the best-known Italian politicians after the Second World War, and a historical figure of the left-wing section of the Christian Democracy. Fanfani was one of the dominant figures of the Italian Christian Democrats for over three decades. Cesare Merzagora was a politician from Milan. He was President of Banca Popolare di Milano from 1950 to 1952, the President of the Italian Senate from 1953 to 1967, and he was also temporarily acting head of State, in the period between the resignation of Antonio Segni and the election of Giuseppe Saragat in 1964. Merzagora was named senator for life in 1963. He was run as a candidate of the Italian Christian Democracy Party, and was affiliated to this party during his whole political career, although he never became an official member.
