Description

Carlo Russo was a politician and leading member of the Christian Democratic Party, he was deputy of the DC from 1948 until 1979. Emilio Colombo was an Italian politician and the Prime Minister of Italy from 1970 to 1972. In addition to having held top positions in Italian governments, he was also active in European politics. Colombo entered politics as a member of the Christian Democracy in 1948. The 'Dorotei' were a group of conservative and strongly anti-Communist politicians within the Christian Democracy. The name 'Dorotei' came from the Convent of Saint Dorothea, where the group was originally founded in 1959.
