Domenico Modugno was an Italian singer, songwriter, actor, guitarist, and later in life, a member of the Italian Parliament. He is known for his 1958 international hit song "Nel blu dipinto di blu". He is considered the first Italian cantautore. Edmo Fenoglio was a film director and screenwriter Italian particularly active for the television between the fifties and eighties. Il marchese di Roccaverdina was a TV mini series in 1972 based on the novel The Marquis of Roccaverdina of Luigi Capuana.
