Emma Elizabeth Irene of the Princess of the Netherlands Orange-Nassau , Princess of Lippe-Biesterfeld (Soestdijk Palace , 5 August 1939) is a Dutch princess, second daughter of Queen Juliana of the Netherlands and her husband the Prince Consort Bernhard of the Netherlands. Carlos Hugo, Duke of Parma and Piacenza (8 April 1930 – 18 August 2010) was the head of the House of Bourbon-Parma from 1977 until his death. Carlos Hugo was the Carlist pretender to the throne of Spain under the name Carlos Hugo I. He sought to change the political direction of the Carlist movement through the Carlist Party, of which he was the official head during the fatal Montejurra Incident.
