**Description**

In 1949, after the local elections, Bartoli became quite naturally the first mayor of Trieste, the expression of a popular choice that undoubtedly had rewarded his party: until then the "President of the City" - after 1948 the "Mayor" - He had been appointed by the GMA authorities. In the early fifties, Bartoli never pulled away from his "centrist" leanings and his uncompromising anti-communism: even in the most dramatic moments, such as the bloody days of March 1953, he showed a total lack of confidence in the socialist party which in those years were, in Rome as in Trieste, close to the party of Togliatti.
