Description

Ettore Troilo was the National Liberation Committee's regional governor of Milan but was removed in 1947 from that role by the minister, Democrat Mario Scelba. The news of his replacement by an official of the state, especially due to the legacy of the past fascist regime, caused a dramatic reaction from the left, which held much sway over the areas around Milan. This led to 156 mayors of the municipalities of Milan and its hinterland resigning en masse. Troilo lived the last decades of his life practicing as a lawyer.
