Roberto Franceschi (Milan , July 23, 1952 - Milan , 30 January 1973) was a young Italian killed in a clash between police and students of Bocconi University of Milan, he was struck by a bullet fired from a weapon supplied to the police force. Mario Capanna (born 10 January 1945) is an Italian politician and writer. Born in Città di Castello, he studied Philosophy at the Catholic University of Milan, and was the leader of the Italian students' movement in the late 1960s and early 1970s. In 1969 he was attacked by exponents of the neo-Fascist Movimento Sociale Italiano.
