The Italian Social Movement (MSI), and later the Italian Social Movement – National Right was a neo-fascist and post-fascist political party in Italy. In June 1974, the Red Brigades committed their first homicide. Two members of the Italian neo-fascist party, Movimento Sociale Italiano (MSI) were killed in Padua during a raid to the MSI headquarters.
