Eugenio Cefis was a business executive and entrepreneur. He was adviser of AGIP, president of ENI and president of Montedison. In 1963 he was honoured with the title of Knight Grand Cross, the highest recognition of the Italian Republic. He was associated with Masonic lodge P2 and the strong suspicions advanced by Mauro de Mauro and Pier Paolo Pasolini on his involvement in the attack on Enrico Mattei, who was succeeded as President of ENI, made him of the most controversial figures in the Italian business environment .
