Description

Franco Freda is a terrorist, publisher, solicitor and attorney a follower of neo-fascism and member of the Political Movement New Order . He was sentenced for a series of bomb attacks (bombs of 25 April 1969 and summer 1969 train bombings) made between the sixties and seventies as part of the so-called strategy of tension. Accused of organising the massacre of Piazza Fontana, it was finally acquitted for lack of evidence (so-called "formula doubtful") by the Assize Court of Appeal of Bari and that of Catanzaro .
