Marino Bon Valsassina was a lawyer and teacher. He graduated from the university of Bologna. He was President of the Italian monarchist Union, and was a local councillor in Rome from 1971 to 1981 as an independent, prior to joining the MSI. He became the political editor at the Journal of Italy and Il Tempo. Thomas Molnar was a Catholic philosopher, historian and political theorist. Molnar completed his undergraduate studies at the University of Brussels in Belgium and received his Ph.D. in philosophy and history from Columbia University in New York City.
