Description

Renato Zangari was an Italian politician and historian. He was a member of the Italian Communist Party. He was elected mayor on July 29, 1970. Whilst he was in office a number of tragic events occurred that severely affected the city: the train massacre "Italicus" of 4 August 1974 where 12 people died and 44 were injured; the killing of Francesco Lorusso on March 11, 1977 and the massacre of August 2, 1980, when a bomb exploded in the waiting room of the railway station, causing 85 deaths.
