Description

In the Basque country in Spain, the ETA militants train their guerilla fighters up in the Pyrenees mountains. ETA (acronym for Euskadi Ta Askatasuna, "Basque Country and Freedom") is an armed Basque nationalist and separatist organization in northern Spain and southwestern France. The group was founded in 1959 and has since evolved from a group promoting traditional Basque culture to a paramilitary group with the goal of gaining independence for the Greater Basque Country.
