Description

A small town, Peio is dwarfed by the large mountains rising up around the Peio Valley in the Stelvio National Park, which also houses the Stelvio Pass, the highest mountain pass in the Eastern Alps. April 1972. The Stelvio Pass is a mountain pass in northern Italy, at an elevation of 2,757 m above sea level. It is the highest paved mountain pass in the Eastern Alps, and the second highest in the Alps, just 13 m below France's Col de l'Iseran.
